True to form, the center — in West Hollywood's Schindler House — has scheduled two such evenings back to back, titled "**sound.**" and showcasing composers who frequently collaborate with visual artists. Friday's program features works by Michael Webster and George Lockwood. Saturday's will be headlined by Tom Rechion and Mark Wheaton. The latter, says the center, will create "a live soundtrack for the unique indoor/outdoor environment of the Schindler House."
